
3. To consider & approve the Annual Report for the year 2014.

The House, in its meeting declared unanimously the following as elected members on the Academic Council out of its own members for a term of two years as provided in the BPSMV Act 2006.



SECTION – 1

THE UNIVERSITY

Genesis

Today's Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya is the 'dream come true' of Bhagat Phool Singh Ji (1885-1942) who established a *Gurukul* for girls at Khanpur Kalan in 1936. After the demise of Bhagat Phool Singh his daughter Subhashini not only took control of *Gurukul* but worked vigorously in expanding the *Gurukul* in terms of its various constituent institutions like BPS Memorial Girls' College (1967), BPS College of Education (1968), MSM Ayurvedic College (1973), BPS Mahila Polytechnic (1984), TIC Bhainswal Kalan (1999) and PSD Girls' Law College (2003).

The State Government upgraded the erstwhile *Gurukul* to the status of a University exclusively for women in August 2006 and christened it as Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, which happens to be the first State Women University of North India. Since then BPSMV has undergone a complete transformation, the *Gurukul* started with only three girls has turned into a modern university with approximately 6500 girls on its rolls studying in various job oriented programmes from KG to Ph.D level. The university has established its two regional centres at Kharal (Jind) and Lula Ahir (Rewari).

Special Achievements

Centre for Indic-Asian Studies (CIAS): BPSMV is the first and only university in Haryana to be awarded prestigious Area Study Centre on Indic Asian Studies of UGC which carry out research on issues related to Indo-Asian knowledge systems. CIAS has operationalized its dedicated participative website www.sharadeshwaranidh.ac.in which contains information on various themes pertaining to Indo-Asian culture and traditions. The centre offers Certificate and Diploma programmes in Indian History and Sanskrit. The centre has published two books of international importance: *Affinities India and Korea: Past and Present* and *Mekong-Ganga Axis*.

Centre for Society University Interface and Research (CSUIR): CSUIR was established in August 2010 with an aim to bridge the disconnection between University and society. It organizes courses and activities which are of direct relevance to the rural community and to formulate schemes that recover traditional good agricultural practices and sustain and conserve the vast knowledge reservoir of rural women. The Centre offers innovative courses in three core areas viz. Integrated Energy Resource Management, Microfinance Practices and Folk Medicine.

Human Resource Development Centre (formerly Academic Staff College): HRDC at BPSMV offers faculty development programmes to in-service college and university teachers and administrators. It organized 03 refresher courses, 03 orientation courses, 02 workshops during the last year. 375 participants attended various programmes organized by the HRDC during the last year.

Front Line Demonstration Centre (FLDC): Based on Indo Israel project, FLDC of excellence in vegetables has been established in 03 acres. The centre trains farmers and women of neighboring villages in educating regarding modern techniques of farming which in turn boosts their economic independence.

Learning Resource Centre (LRC): The Learning Resource Centre has six state-of-the-art Language Labs, equipped with latest technological software which helps in effective learning of language skills which are compulsory to learn for all the enrolled students. LRC also imparts training & guidance for appearing in International English proficiency examinations like Business English Certificate (BEC). The LRC is also the research centre for American interns from St. Catherine University from USA to complete their internship programme.

Staff Training and Research Institute for Teaching of English (STRITE): STRITE has been established as an autonomous Institute of BPSMV for imparting training in effective teaching of English & operation of language laboratory to school & college teachers. So far STRITE has conducted 10 Teacher Training Programmes.

University Placement and Counseling Cell (UPACC): UPACC provides free placement and counseling guidance to all the students.

University Centre for Judicial Services (UCJS): UCJS has been established in the University for imparting coaching and guidance for entering into judicial services. So far 12 students have cleared judicial services examination of various States.

Central Library: The Central Library was established in 2007 has a stock of approximately 110000 books. It has approximately 7000 users and subscribes to 55 National and International Journals, 100 Magazines & Periodicals and 22 Newspapers (Hindi & English). The library provides access to JSTOR, OXFORD UNIVERSITY PRESS, WILEY INDIA, SPRINGER LINK, TAYLOR AND FRANCIS, JCCC, EBIN ONLINE, WEST LAWS,

and MANUPATRA through UGC INFONET Digital Libraries Consortium. The university has the membership of Developing Library Network (DELNET), Delhi. The central library organized a workshop on Institutional Repository (IR) scheme.

International MOUs: BPSVV has signed MOUs with UNDP, ICSI, Kwangwoon University, South Korea and St. Catherine University, USA.

Social Outreach Programmes Organized

Village Adoption: B.P S Institute of Teacher Training and Research adopted five villages in the vicinity of the university namely Kasanda, Kasandi, Karkana, Gamri and Garhi Ljale Khan and native village Khanpur Kalan.. The step streamlined and gave a decisive direction to the already active Social Services as it enabled us to focus our energies on the four adopted villages. For example *Naidad Natak* and Skits related to "*shaskat nari jagruk smaj*" were performed to spread messages of social significance among the villagers.

Literacy and Awareness Camps: The ITTR took active initiatives in educating the villagers, especially women, sensitizing them to the benefits of a better life. The students of the ITTR interacted with the villagers in their native environment internalizing their perspectives and then dialogically coming to better solutions that bring about a change for the better. In addition, non-formal schools for the children of labourers in Medical College, Khanpur Kalan, have been established by the ITTR

Educating to Liberate: The villagers, especially women, were imparted basic education by the students of the ITTR enabling them to be self-sustaining and self-sufficient in daily activities like banking, signing, applying for various facilities like the *Aadhar Card*, Birth Certificates, Death Certificates, Pension schemes, etc. This liberation goes a long way in raising their confidence and self-esteem. Moreover, the students also studied the causes of dropouts in these villages and how these hurdles could be removed to achieve 100% literacy. The idea of complete literacy was extended further when the village women were taught by the students of the ITTR during their field work. In addition, in response to the

demand from certain villages regarding scarcity of teachers, the students of ITTR met classes to make up for the loss of studies of the students.

Garbage Disposal & Productivity out of Waste: The students of the ITTR, during their visits to the villages, felt it was high time to boost the villagers conscience regarding the significance of cleanliness and hence, the proper disposal of garbage. The students not only initiated the villagers into maintaining clean surroundings but also taught them to distinguish between useful and waste garbage. In addition, they were also taught about the proper way of disposing off waste garbage and also utilizing reusable garbage like manufacturing bowls out of paper and products of daily use out of plastic.

Optimal Utilization of Resources: The students also acquainted the villagers about optimal use of natural resources so that wastage is reduced to a minimum. This ensured a clean village and lower rate of consumption of non-renewable resources. The visits acquainted the villagers with ways to save water and land from being polluted and the impact of population growth. The villagers were also sensitized about the ill-effects of urbanization and industrialization and were given basic knowledge of cost-effective and practical steps to curb pollution.

Awareness against Social Ills: The ITTR also took initiatives to nurture a healthy life style amongst the villagers and also organized various Medical Camps in the villages to diagnose any diseases that might have found their way to the villagers. The students visited the villages and organized literacy cum awareness camps. The basic idea was to create awareness about different educational and social issues haunting the society and the various solutions to eradicate them. The camps also addressed different issues immediately related to the villagers, like drug addiction, female feticide, personal hygiene, environment awareness, Govt. Policies, etc. The *Aanganwadi* workers were also involved in the entire exercise and were initially sensitized and then given the onus of sensitizing the villagers. The visits and the involvement of the *Aanganwadi* workers was aimed at spreading awareness about various ill's ailing the society namely female feticide, dowry, domestic violence, AIDS and alcoholism and various feasible solutions like Clean India Drive, *Bea Bachao Beti Padhao*, vaccination and literacy.

Gita Jayanti: Villagers were told about importance of the Geeta and how these shlokas are helpful in our lives. Geeta Jyanti Mahotsav was also celebrated with full enthusiasm. As a part of the *Gita Jayanti* celebrations, various programmes were organized in the adopted villages. *Shlokas* from the *Bhagwad Gita* reverberated the atmosphere and eminent Brahman and Arya Samajist scholars addressed gatherings in the villages.

Legal Awareness: It is inevitable for a nation to have knowledge of its law and order. For this legal awareness was spreaded among women masses by the students during field work.

Women Day Celebration: Women day was celebrated on March 8, 2016 by the ITTR. On this occasion, ITTR organised poster making and slogan competitions. Mrs Dharti Dainas ,D.S.P, Sanipat expressed her views on women empowerment. She also explained various techniques of self defence for women. Women of different adopted villages are called in ITTR for the celebration and made to learn some simple self defence techniques.

Motivational Talk: Ms. Anuradha Saroj Beniwal gave a motivational talk on women empowerment. She shared her life experiences with the students. She said that we should give freedom to the girls for their bright future.

Food Preparation:The villagers were trained by the students about hygienic food preparation and the different ways to cook food by optimally utilizing the resources.

Knitting & Stitching: Knitting and Stitching is an important art. Women were made to learn stitching by students of ITTR. The hallmark of the Social Outreach Programme was the exhibition of Hand-made materials related to *Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Abhiyan*.

Training as Beauticians: The villagers are also trained in applying and using beauty products by the students. The purpose is to open an additional avenue to financial independence for women, who, after getting training, may open small entrepreneurial avenues for themselves.

Dari Making: In an attempt to provide self-employment without much investment, the villagers were trained in indigenous techniques in *Dari* making from waste resources.

Mehandi and Nail Art: In present scenario, the craze of Mehandi designing and Nail Art

are very popular among the girls and women. In this direction, ITTR organized a training programme for women for mehendi designing and nail art in various adopted villages. The Village women were taught how to apply mehendi on their hands during this programme. The purpose of this programme is to open an additional avenue to financial independence for women.

Guidance and Counseling: The ITTR offers Counselling to the villagers in the villages where the students and the faculty interact with villagers regarding their social issues.

Donations: The students of ITTR also volunteered to donate various infrastructural devices to schools and villages so that the students and the villagers do not lag behind in any essentials during their teaching practices.

Programmes Organized:

Adrash Gaon Banane Hatu Ek Dwasya Paricharcha: The sarpanch, panch and villagers of the five adopted villages and Khanpur Kalan were invited to the ITTR to participate and express their views and opinions on the social issues prevailing in the society and their possible remedies. The interaction strove to bring different stake holders in the society on the same platform for deliberations.

One Day Training Programme: Miss World Aditi Arya visited ITTR on 19-05-2015. She interacted with *Aanganwadi* workers of nearby villages and the students of ITTR. Focussing on the significance of a comprehensive personality she talked to the workers on improving their personality and spreading the ambience of their pleasing personality to the villagers. The interaction aimed at nurturing a composite personality of the *Aanganwadi* workers so that they can set examples for others to emulate in the villages.

Plantation and Cleanliness Drive on 'Swachh Harit Aem Nirmal Bharat Ki Aur Ek Kadam'
: A plantation and cleanliness drive was organized in *Aanganwadi* and Govt. Primary School, in village Kasanda . Apart from it an exhibition '*vrishik jagoo vrishik jagoo jeevan me bhoryali jagoo*' and '*Swachh Harit Aem Nirmal Bharat Ki Aur Ek Kadam*' was arranged by the students of BPS:ITTR.

Health Check-up Camp: In the month of July, the ITTR organized a free Health Check-up camp in Gamri. Alongside the camp by the Institute of Ayurveda, an exhibition on *Beti Bachao Beti Padhao* and various social issues to sensitize the villagers was also organized. The exercises were in addition to the Teaching being done by the students of ITTR in the Govt school there, an activity that was witnessed and assessed by two interns from Hong Kong.

Breast Feeding Week Celebrations: The ITTR celebrated the Breast Feeding Week in various villages. The students of the ITTR interacted with the villagers spreading awareness about the social and physical harms of female feticide and the importance of breast feeding to the new-born baby.

Human Rights Day: The University celebrated, with fanfare, the International Human Rights Day in Gamri. The students interacted with the villagers and sensitized them towards their rights and responsibilities

Awareness Camp: An Awareness Camp on *Beti Bachao Beti Padhao* was organized by ITTR, at various adopted villages. The theme was to spread awareness about the importance of girl child and her education. A *Nritya Natika* related to *Beti Bachao Beti Padhao* was also performed to further highlight the importance of daughters. *Beti Bachao Natak* Natak was played by the students of ITTR in various villages during their field work. After the natak the students highlighted the salient features of *Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Abhiyaan* and its significance in contemporary social order. They asserted that educated girls are a prerequisite to a progressive and developed society.
